The easy way in ... Getting to the PCEC is easy. If you're not driving, there are many transport options that bring you to the door of the centre - or at least a short stroll away.

Walking Feel like some fresh air and the opportunity to enjoy Perth's fabulous weather? The PCEC is located next to the Swan River and its many walking paths. From South Perth, the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre is a 20-minute stroll over the Narrows Bridge. From Perth's Central Business District, the PCEC is between a 5-minute and 15-minute walk, depending on your starting point.

And from West Perth, just walk down King's Park Road and onto St Georges Terrace before heading down to the PCEC.

Cycling Perth's cycle paths are superb and intersect the city area from all directions.

Taxi Perth's taxi drivers are well known as being friendly and helpful. There are taxi ranks near the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre and taxis can also be hailed from the street. Taxis can drop off guests in a "drop-off zone" in the PCEC's arrival plaza. When booking a taxi, make sure you advise the taxi companies of special requirements. Bus There are 13 bus service areas within the Perth region, with four major bus operators. Perth's central bus station, known as the BusPort, is located adjacent to the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre and bus services to all suburbs of Perth are frequent.

All public buses in central city area operate under a Free Transit Zone whereby passengers can travel on any Transperth bus for free, as often as they want, as long as they embark and disembark within the city boundaries.

Train Perth's train system is operated by Westrail. The brand new Esplanade train station right next to the PCEC is now open with trains running regularly. For train timetables and further information, see [www.transperth.wa.gov.au](http://www.transperth.wa.gov.au)

Ferry Perth Water Transport operates ferries from the Barrack Street jetty in Perth to the South Perth foreshore. The Barrack Street jetty is a five-minute walk from the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre. **Parking** The City of Perth owns and operates the carpark at the PCEC through its business unit City of Perth Parking (CPP). The carpark is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week except for maintenance and servicing. Fully-trained customer service staff are in attendance.

Rates for 2009/2010 (subject to increase) are:

There are also approximately 5,000 car parking spaces within 1.5 km of the PCEC, including the 1,500 car parking spaces available at the PCEC managed by the City of Perth.

Organisers can reserve limited car parking space in the PCEC Car Park for organisers to be used during the contracted move-in, event and move-out dates. Multiple entry passes can be booked with your event manager. Current prices for reserved parking are (subject to increase):

**24 Hour, Multiple Entry - \$24.00 per ticket (up to 200 tickets)**

This option provides a 24 hour multiple entry and exit. Unless indicated otherwise, ticket validity times will be from midnight until midnight on nominated date.

**10 Hours Continuous Parking, Single Entry - \$20.00 per ticket**

This option provides single entry and exit, 10 hours continuous parking. Event organisers are required to nominate an arrival time on nominated date.

Patrons parking longer than planned are responsible for paying any additional parking fees. To arrange payment patrons should visit CPP Customer Service Office located in the carpark before returning to their vehicle.

Please note that two weeks advance notice is required to lodge your PCEC Parking Ticket Application for pre-paid parking tickets. For orders of 200 tickets and above, four weeks advance notice is required.

Event organisers are responsible for distributing parking tickets to participants prior to the event day and parking tickets are valid even if the car park sign says full.

Alternate Parking

Due to it's popularity, the Convention Centre Carpark tends to fill up quickly mid week. However, alternate parking is available within a short walk of the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre.
